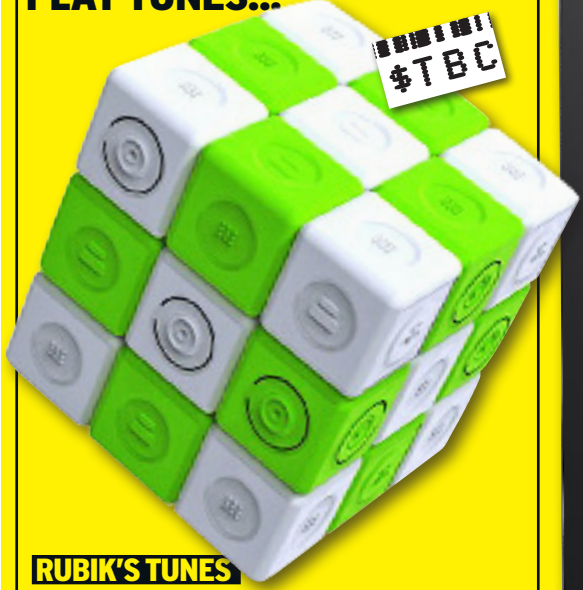




MUSICAL NOKIA
